ARTIST INVITATION & AGREEMENT

Dear Artist:

We cordially invite you to participate in this year's Prayers from LA, Art & Performance Benefit Festival at Casa0101. We believe that your participation is important and pertinent to the collection, exhibition, and documentation of these works, these events, and this movement. If you would create a work that reflects what you are most concerned with in this day and age, we believe we can bring together a strong encompassing group of works.

We ask that you represent your voice this year. What are your *prayers*, hopes, dreams, desires, wishes, concerns... for the world today? Share and exhibit your miniature *prayer* art piece this year.

"Some of us practice *prayers* day to day as a spiritual summoning composed of spoken word, altars and incense, some practice through mediation, and for others it's just being able to visually articulate expressions of hope, love and peace. In this show, we will refer to the Concept of Prayer as a means to reflect our collective ties and social concerns in the world, in our society, community, our humanity." – Margaret Garcia

We invite you to join this movement of "prayers" and come together, put egos aside, speak with each other through our artwork in a manner that cultivates positivism and community building. Let's show each other, and our oppressors our humanity while we protest in this artful and heartfelt way. Show what you are for, what you support, what you love... Come join us. Help us bring something special to the community, to support local artists and vendors, and to support the cause. Help us create a beautiful, holistic documentation and publication of the group of works represented by joining us with your art piece(s).

We would like to extend our invitation to you to come share your thoughts, concerns, and visual expressions in your medium of choice, to exhibit at the Jean Deleage Gallery at Casa0101.

Dimension requirements: Art pieces must be on the mini/small side of the scale. We don't like to place strict limitations on our participants and just ask that you be mindful – mindful of the themes and that it is an inclusive exhibit: you will be sharing the wall space, spectacularly, with other artists. The usual suggestion is that "prayer" art pieces stick to being about the size of your hand. Emphasis on intimate, smaller pieces.

Duration of Works on Loan, Manner of Exhibition. (The Artist) hereby agrees to loan *Prayers from LA* and *Casa0101*, the work(s) listed below for the period of time from <u>December 15th through December 19th, 2016</u> in participation with our annual *Prayers from LA*, *Art & Performance Benefit Festival* taking place this year on December 17th, 2016. *Prayers from LA* and *Casa0101* agrees to exhibit selected art works listed on the Information Sheet below, for our inclusive *Prayers from LA Art Exhibit*. The work(s) shall be kept on the *Casa0101* premises and shall not be removed until after the event is finished and exhibit closed.

Delivery, Care, and Condition. There are several options for artwork delivery.

Option 1) Artwork is to be delivered during any day of the week during *Casa0101* office hours of 11am to 6pm M-F prior to the event at *Casa0101*, preferably by December 15th, 2016. This will give us time to ideally hang your art piece(s). The location address for drop off at *Casa0101* is 2102 East First Street, Los Angeles, CA 90033. *Casa0101* representatives and assistants will exercise the utmost care in handling all artwork and are

insured. Jimmy Centeno is the regular curator of the Jean Deleage Gallery of *Casa0101* and you may contact him as well at curator@casa0101.org for assistance.

Option 2) Margaret Garcia Studio and Gallery upon appointment/scheduling to confirm open hours. Please contact before drop-off at this location.

Option 3) Contact the organizer/curator, Nataasja Saint-Satyr who will arrange pick-up/shipment options.

Option 4) Bring your "prayer" art piece in hand to the event on the day of the event December 17th, 2016

Framing and Installation. The Artist agrees to deliver each work framed properly and/or ready for installation. The Artist needs submit the information for their art pieces including title, year, artist name, work medium/materials, dimensions, and sale price, if for sale. The Artist may list this information on the Information Sheet and attach an artist statement with bio to this page when submitting their work(s).

Sale. Artwork for sale will be on a 50/50 split and is accepted on a consignment basis; 50% of proceeds will go to the artist directly and 50% will go to the community cause and benefit as a charitable donation. The Artist's representative or representative gallery commission fees will be taken from the Artist's percentage. The Artist will receive a check for their portion of the sale no later than 2 weeks after the end of the event and exhibition OR no later than 2 weeks after completed payment on artwork has been received.

Reproduction. The Artist agrees to the reproduction of exhibited artwork for publicity or documentary purposes in all forms of media.

Expectation. Prayers from LA and Casa0101 will advertise and promote the work of the Artist leading up to and during the scheduled exhibition period. We will discuss with the artist possible activities during the run of the show that would help promote the work. Prayers from LA and Casa0101 will mail invitations to our mailing list encouraging attendance. Sales of the Artist's work will be actively sought and encouraged. In return, the Artist will supply Prayers from LA and Casa0101 with a statement about his/her work encouraging a better understanding of the Artist's work. The Artist will discuss with Prayers from LA and Casa0101 any special events, discussions, or presentations that each agree would help promote the Exhibition. **The Artist will mail/distribute invitations to his/her personal guests encouraging attendance**. The Artist will attend the exhibit and special event on December 17th, 2016.

Donations. If you are donating artwork and have pieces that are not only on loan for the exhibit, please contact Nataasja Saint-Satyr to arrange delivery and submissions. The donating Artist will be sent a separate letter pertaining to his charitable donation. *Prayers from LA* and *Casa0101* thank you for your support.

Thank You for Your Participation. *Prayers from LA* and *Casa0101* would like to thank you for your participation in our festival this year. Thank you for your voice and your support. You will receive a personal letter of thanks upon your full submission. The letter will also serve as our confirmation of your participation and our reception of your work(s), Information Sheet, and (if any) Statement/Bio. Thank you.
